


# XTM Connect

Here is the method for connecting XTM to XTRF:

Have sales/support enable the API in XTM

Then: go to XTRF as per the screenshot I provided here and then: put the following details into the fields:

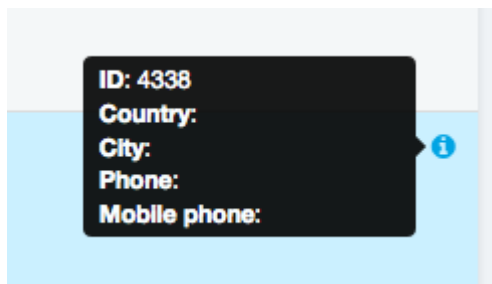
